

GUIDELINES: SUBSCRIBING TO ISIS CC FIXTURES

(TO LOAD LIVE FIXTURE UPDATES TO YOUR PERSONAL CALENDAR)

These are guidelines only as phone models and software versions will differ for different people. For more help use a prompt such as this in an AI tool (e.g. ChatGPT, CoPilot, Gemini et al) –

Please give me user instructions to subscribe to an iCalendar in Google Calendar on my Google Pixel 9A phone (replacing “Google Calendar” and “Google Pixel 9A” with whatever software and phone model you are using)

1. Subscription - Google and Android Phones

Google does not let you add an iCalendar URL directly in the Android Google Calendar app. Google says you must first subscribe using Google Calendar in a computer web browser; it will then sync to the Calendar app on your Android Phone.

1.1 On your PC

1. Sign in to the account you use on your Android phone, and open Google Calendar from the applications menu (9-dot box, top right).
2. In the left-hand panel, find Other calendars.
3. Click the + alongside it.
4. Select “From URL”.
5. Enter the Isis CC iCalendar subscription URL:
<https://www.isiscc.org.uk/assets/calendar/isiscc-fixtures-current.ics>
6. Click Add calendar (The calendar should appear under **Other calendars** as **Isis CC Fixtures**.)

1.2 Then on your Android phone

1. Open the Google Calendar app
2. Tap **Settings**.
3. Look for **Isis CC Fixtures**. If you don't immediately see it, tap **Show more** under the relevant Google account.
4. Tap **Isis CC Fixtures**.
5. Make sure **Sync** is switched **ON**.
6. Go back to the calendar, tap , and make sure the box alongside **Isis CC Fixtures** is ticked.

Google explicitly notes that it can take some time for events to appear after Sync is enabled.

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2. Subscription - Outlook (Office 365)

1. Sign in to Outlook at <https://outlook.live.com/>
2. Switch to Calendar
3. Choose "Add Calendar"
4. Choose "Subscribe from web"
5. Paste the iCalendar URL:
<https://www.isiscc.org.uk/assets/calendar/isiscc-fixtures-current.ics>
6. Give your calendar a name (I suggest "IsisCC Fixtures")
7. Click Import

My experience is that Outlook may not always refresh changes to a subscribed calendar promptly. If fixture information appears out of date, removing the Isis CC Fixtures calendar and subscribing again will retrieve the latest version.

3. Subscription – Apple Mac

1. Open the Calendar app.
2. Choose File → New Calendar Subscription.
3. Enter the Isis CC iCalendar URL:
<https://www.isiscc.org.uk/assets/calendar/isiscc-fixtures-current.ics>
4. Click Subscribe.
5. Enter a name such as IsisCC Fixtures.
6. Choose a colour if required.
7. For Location, choose iCloud. This is useful because Apple says an iCloud calendar subscription can then appear on your other Apple devices signed into the same Apple Account.
8. Click OK.

4. Subscription - Apple iPhone/iPad

For current **iOS 26/iPadOS 26** or later:

1. Open **Calendar**.
2. Tap **Calendars**.
3. Tap **Add Calendar**.
4. Tap **Add Subscription Calendar**.
5. Enter the Isis CC iCalendar URL:
<https://www.isiscc.org.uk/assets/calendar/isiscc-fixtures-current.ics>
6. Tap **Find**.
7. Give it a title such as **IsisCC Fixtures** and choose a colour if desired.
8. Next to **Account**, choose **iCloud**.
9. Tap **Done**.

GUIDELINES: ONE-OFF DOWNLOAD **(To LOAD FIXTURES TO YOUR PERSONAL CALENDAR)**

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Please give me user instructions to perform a one-off download of an iCalendar in Google Calendar on my Google Pixel 9A phone (replacing “Google Calendar” and “Google Pixel 9A” with whatever software and phone model you are using)

For all one-off download guidelines below, firstly download the iCalendar from
<https://www.isiscc.org.uk/assets/calendar/isiscc-fixtures-current.ics>

1. Google Calendar — one-off import

1. Sign in to Google and load the Google Calendar Application
2. Choose Settings.
3. Select Import & Export.
4. Import the downloaded file (from your downloads folder).

2. Outlook — one-off import in Microsoft Office

1. Navigate to your downloads file and double-click the file,
or choose File → Open & Export → Import/Export → Import an iCalendar (.ics) → and then
navigate to your downloads folder and select the isiscc-fixtures-current.ics file.
2. Choose whether to create a new calendar or import into an existing one.

3. Apple Calendar — one-off import on a Mac

1. Open the downloaded isiscc-fixtures-current.ics file. It should open in the Calendar app.
Apple confirms that .ics files can be imported into Calendar.
2. When Calendar asks where the events should be added, choose the calendar in which you
want the Isis CC fixtures stored.
3. Confirm the import.

4. Apple Calendar (iPhone/iPad) — one-off import

1. Email the isiscc-fixtures-current.ics file to yourself and open the attachment in Mail on your
device.
2. Tap the .ics attachment/file.
3. iOS/iPadOS should display the calendar events contained in it.
4. Choose the option to **add the events to Calendar** and select the calendar into which you
want them imported.
5. Confirm the import.
